# i. Condition of grass triangle – Bottom Lane:

The quarry has approved the application for the donation of some large stones should the PC decide they are suitable for the appearance of the area. The area would require levelling and there is an inspection cover in the centre that needs to be kept clear. Highways have approved in principle the plans but stipulated that the planters/stones need to be set back 600mm from the edge of the running line. The S115E licence for Vobster and this land is £500 for both which was approved. Once levelled and protected, bicycle racks and a bench may be considered.

#### ii. Telephone box:

The school are aware that the box has become a dumping ground for books and had been looking at the possibility of having a defibrillator so would like the PC to pursue this option.
