- a) Broadband Truespeed. There has been a low take-up in Mells. 40% to 50% have reasonable broadband speeds for the present from BT, but greater speeds will be needed in the near future. Large banners in the village, and door-to-door visits by councilors were proposed in order to raise awareness.
- **b)** Barn Lease: Still no response from the solicitors, Harris and Harris. John Earl is exploring alternative plans.
- c) Old Telephone Exchange: Enforcement notice imminent.
- d) Data Protection: Awaiting return of Parish Clerk.
- e) **Dumped Car Fairview.** Mendip is aware, and processing removal.
- f) Fire Hydrants: Fire service has contacted Clerk and informed her that the two hydrants will be inspected mid September. The rest would be inspected during the annual inspection later this year.
- **7.** WAR MEMORIAL UPKEEP: Monica Jennings and June Costelloe have been tending the memorial for many years. New volunteers needed. Clare Asquith to research.

a) Lime Kiln Hill – obscured repeater signs. John Earl to check if signs still not visible.
